Delivered to date:

We started with a dream of living in Venezuela's beautiful rainforest.

We are now the largest NGO of its kind in the northeastern state of Sucre.

**100,000+** women & families directly served with family planning

**17,915+** tubal ligation and vasectomy surgeries

**5,800+** reproductive health education workshops delivered to

**153,950+** participants (primarily adolescents and young adults)

**32,500+** additional medical assists (primary & secondary healthcare)

**1,700+** additional surgeries (hernias, etc.)

**Annual** high school and college scholarships empowering young women

**Diverse** eco-agricultural initiatives including The Durian Project



## Impacts 1997-2025\*

**182,131** unintended pregnancies *averted*  
**64,274** unsafe abortions *averted*  
**311** child deaths *averted*

**38,402** total Disability-Adjusted Life Years *averted*  
**\$11.14M** saved in direct healthcare  
costs (2025 USD estimated)

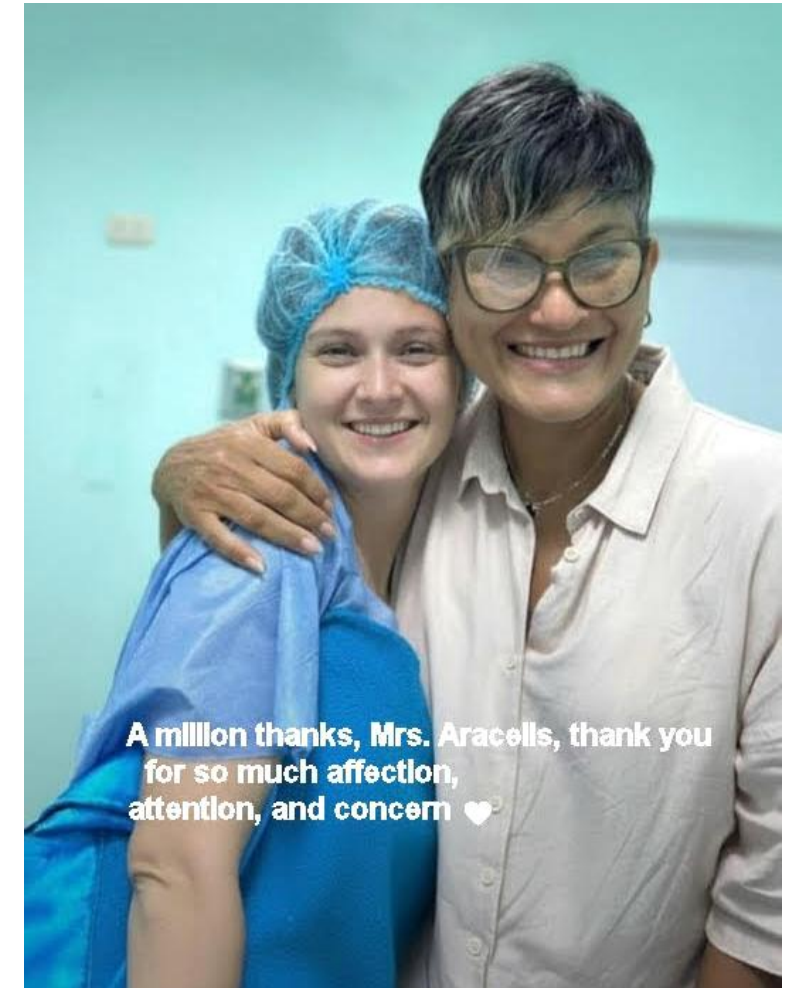
# Our valued partners

- Based on what low-income families **tell us** that they want and need



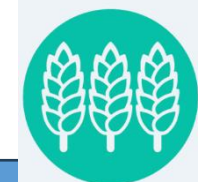

# Family Planning

As of September 2025:

- **338,313** Couple Years of Protection (CYPs) delivered to 100,000+ women, men, and their families through a range of contraceptive methods
- **17,915** tubal ligations and vasectomies delivered to clients who qualify: *Our most popular and sought-after service*
- Partnerships with public hospitals, private clinics, and urban and rural out-patient *ambulatorios*: *All services implemented by Venezuelan professionals in accordance with Venezuelan public health policies*

- **5,800+** Reproductive Health Workshops delivered to **153,950+** teenagers, students, and adults
- Focus on adolescents: *Venezuela has some of the highest teenage pregnancy rates in Latin America*
- Mobile teams of social workers, health care providers, and educators: *We go where our clients are*
- Reliable, quality first: *Our reputation for quality is built by word-of-mouth (marketing is not required)*





## Medical Assists / Humanitarian Aid



As of September 2025:

- **1,700+** additional medical procedures and surgeries: *Hernias, biopsies, etc.*
- **25,350+** consultations in primary and secondary healthcare: *Gynecology, orthopedics, urology, cardiology, oncology, pediatrics, etc.*
- **7,150+** assists with lab work, imaging, medicine, eyecare, nutrition, and more: *Helping the underserved with basic healthcare services.*
- Partnership with **Fundación Esperanza Rosa** to combat breast cancer







# Rural Education



- Direct support of rural literacy, elementary, and high school education programs: *Many students are the first in their families to graduate from high school!*
- Sponsorships for select college students based on merit: *From illiteracy to college degree in one generation!*
- Rural Education Center: *In remote community, several hours walking from the road.*
- Free Internet access in both urban and rural settings.







# Sustainable Livelihood

- **Eco-agriculture** emphasizing tree farming as a commercially-viable option for low-income farmers:

*Alternative to the deforestation and erosion produced by slash-and-burn swidden agriculture*

- **The Durian Project** fostering Durian and other fruit (Mangosteen, Jackfruit, etc.) as lucrative cash crops:

*We may have the only producing durian and mangosteen trees in Venezuela – a huge opportunity for campesinos to join the lucrative durian economy*

- **Rural Infrastructure:**

*Public trail improvements, community projects, solar panels and gravity-piped clean water installed for communities in remote rural river valleys*
