2025 CALENDAR YEAR ACHIEVEMENTS

- **6572 Family Planning Services** delivered, including **3275 first-time clients**.
- **27,582 Couple Years of Protection (CYPs)**, the internationally accepted metric for family planning achievement.
- **1527 Medical Consultations** in reproductive health and other primary health care.
- **2126 Medical Follow-ups:** Lab work, imaging, medicine, eyeglasses, nutrition, biopsies and treatments.
- **1457 Surgeries:** Tubal sterilizations, vasectomies, hernia repairs, various gynecological, orthopedic, oncological, pediatric, ophthalmologic, and ENT procedures.
- **778 Reproductive Health Workshops** for **38,316 participants** focusing on teenagers, students, young adults, and public health and education personnel.
- **Primary and Secondary Rural School Support** offering school supplies, cyber computers, Internet and onsite tutoring.
- **Scholarship Program** for 50+ secondary students at a remote rural high school and 10 selected college students.
- **Emergency Assistance** to alleviate critical problems associated with poverty, such as childhood malnutrition.
- **Fruit Tree Distribution** in various rural communities. Durian and mangosteen are the lucrative Asian fruits highly sought after by Chinese and Asian populations in Venezuela, with increasing popularity among native Venezuelans as well. Expanding tree farming with unusual tropical fruits is an economically-viable way to rebuild the deforested landscapes of rural Venezuela and provide local farmers with new revenue streams.
- **Infrastructure Projects** that benefit the rural community as a whole, such as maintaining the schools, bridge, trails, and water and electric systems.

- **84,960 low-income women and their families have received family planning**

- **6071 Reproductive Health Workshops** attended by **164,826 participants**.
- **Small Rural Library & Computer Facility** established, staffed and maintained two hours walking distance from the nearest road, with subsidized school supplies and tutoring offered.
- **Development and distribution of less-known tropical fruit trees**, such as durian, mangosteen, jackfruit, biriba, and star fruit, with commercial potential for local farmers. **Tree permaculture** conserves the tropical environment and ameliorates climate warming.
- **Support for Infrastructure Projects** to enhance the quality of life in our target rural community: maintaining the bridge, trails, remote schools, and off-the-grid water and electric systems.

CUMULATIVE IMPACTS to date: MAY 1997 – SEPTEMBER 2025*

- **182,131 Unintended Pregnancies** averted
- **64,274 unsafe abortions** averted
- **311 child deaths** averted (mortalities)
- **187 maternal deaths** averted (mortalities)
- **38,402 total Disability-Adjusted Life Years** averted (morbidity)
- **\$11.14M** saved in direct healthcare costs (2025 USD estimated)
